The primary focus of this position will be working directly with resident and non-resident children in a supportive capacity, engaging them in age-appropriate activities while their mother may or may not be in the facility. The Child-Minding position will be a positive role model and sensitive to the needs of diverse groups of children.

- Experience working with children in a group setting.
- Interest in reading, literacy development, arts and crafts.
- Interest and ability to participate in varied physical activities.
- Education and/or training in child development is an asset.
- Experience working with children who have experienced trauma, poverty, or homelessness is an asset.
- Pleasant personal manner.
- Cross cultural sensitivity and knowledge of diversity.
- Be able to obtain a Criminal Records Check.
- Have valid CPR Level C and First Aid
